**Position Description:**

The Athletics Sustainability Intern will be responsible for analyzing Athletics' existing sustainability practices, identifying opportunities for improvement, and implementing strategic changes. Specific duties include:

- Development and implementation of ongoing sustainability in athletics brand and supporting marketing initiatives, including student athlete engagement
- Implementation support for waste bin infrastructure and signage changes at Athletics facilities
- Game day support, especially during football season, including:
  - Tailgate recycling and composting
  - Fan engagement initiatives
  - Concessions staff and volunteer training
  - Recruitment of volunteers for waste station monitoring
- Support for other sustainability projects in Athletics facilities as needed, including energy retrofits, water efficiency, and behavior change campaigns
- Increased involvement with Green Sports Alliance and Pac-12 Sustainability Working Group

5-10 hours a week for the 2020-2021 Academic Year
